OFFICE OF ADMISSIONS

- Fill out a Navarro College Application for Admissions on <u>Apply Texas</u> (<u>www.applytexas.org</u>)
- Turn in a copy of your DD214 (if applicable) with your NC Application (Note: In order to be exempt from the TSI Test you MUST have an Honorable Discharge after 8/1/1990) If you do not have your DD214, you can request to have one mailed to you by completing the steps located on <u>NARA</u> (https://vetrecs.archives.gov/VeteranRequest/home.html) (National Archives and Records Administration).
- All students under the age of 22 will need to provide the Registrar's Office with proof of the Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination. A student may obtain an extension form to register if on the day the student plans to register he/she does not have proof of the vaccination.
- Turn in a copy of your official High School Transcript, GED transcript, or other official College Transcripts to the Registrar's Office (Note: Please visit <u>Texas Education Agency</u> (http://tea.texas.gov/GED.html) where you can purchase and download your GED Transcript for \$5)
- The Office of Admissions will supply you with your chosen Degree Plan. You will need this Degree Plan in order to register for class.

OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

- o Turn in a copy of your NOBE (*Notice of Basic Eligibility*) if you are a National Guard or reserve member.
- o Turn in a copy of your military transcript by request that an official copy be sent to Navarro College by registering and logging on to <u>Joint Services Transcript</u> (<u>https://jst.doded.mil</u>).
- Request an evaluation of your military education experiences by creating an account on <u>College Credit</u> for <u>Heroes</u> (https://www.collegecreditforheroes.org/) and requesting your CCH Transcript to be sent to Navarro College.
- To begin the process for receiving your VA Educational Benefits logon to <u>VONAPP</u> (http://vabenefits.vba.va.gov) (Veterans On-Line Application) and fill out Form: 22-1990 (if you have never used your federal benefit) or 22-1995 (if you have used your federal benefit before).
- You will receive a letter from the VA Regional Office stating what your Federal Educational Benefits consist of approximately 20 days from the day you submit your application. *Ensure that your VA Certifying Official receives a copy of this letter.*
- Members using Chapter 1606 (MGIB-SR) must call 1.877.823.2378 or log on to <u>W.A.V.E</u> (https://www.gibill.va.gov/wave/) (Web Automated Verification of Enrollment) on the last day of each month to verify that their enrollment has not changed since the last verification. * If you *do not* take this necessary step, you will *not* be paid.*
